This booklet on the app will be kept with you at all times. READ IT CAREFULLY! It is your responsibility to follow the itinerary. Failure to comply with times, responsibilities, or duties may result in loss of privileges or being sent home.

You are responsible for loading your own luggage, marching uniform, and all performance equipment on and off of the busses. ALWAYS double check - never assume it is there.

- □ Do not leave small instruments on the bus overnight. Large cases, flags, drums, banner and supply cases may be left under the bus.
- □ Keep the bus clean and quiet and the driver happy. Greet them, they are important to us!
- Your App on the phone with this information is your ticket to board the bus. No Band Bible - No Board. Stay informed.
- You will need to sign out on the clipboard if you exit the bus on overnight stops. This is the easiest way for us to keep track of who has gotten off the bus without turning on the lights and waking everyone up. Don't get off overnight if you don't need to.
- □ Attendance will be taken each time we board the bus. Sit down quickly and stay quiet until we are done. Wasted time means scary Haas.
- Don't be the last one on the bus. Always know where it will be parked.
- Don't wander away alone at any time. Two or more is the rule when not with the chaperon group. Check in with chaperon via selfies and groupies showing your face and your location 2 times each day. 1 face to face meeting with chaperon each day also.
- □ Failure to comply will result in loss of privileges or riding Dumbo, Small World and Winnie the Pooh all day with Mrs. Haas.
- Give your chaperon and group your full cooperation.
- □ Eat breakfast daily in groups so you can plan your day's events.
- □ If there is ever a problem, call a chaperon. Go to First Aid if needed.

- □ NO ONE is allowed outside of, or in other rooms for any reason after curfew. Failure to comply will send you home. A hotel security guard will also be making frequent rounds.
- □ There is NO NEED to be in rooms of the opposite sex.
- Running, loud socializing, or any poor behavior will not be tolerated in the hotel rooms or halls. Use the lobby or common areas to socialize. BE SMART - BE MATURE.
- Absolutely no use of illegal substances including cigarettes and vapes for all trip participants regardless of age. This will result in being sent home and/or not being able to march in the parade. We can do this performance without you, so don't do anything stupid. It will be your loss.
- Dress responsibly. Drugs, alcohol or other inappropriate subjects on clothing should be left at home. School dress code applies, and if I don't like your clothing choice, I'll make you go back to your room and change.
- Do not charge anything to the room.

- □ KEEP ROOMS IN RESPECTABLE CONDITION, CLEANER THAN YOUR ROOM AT HOME.
- □ Keep cash, credit cards and valuables out of sight.
- □ Take a picture of your Disney Passport and Universal ticket, and also write down the numbers. In case of loss, those numbers are needed to issue a replacement.
- □ Keep those tickets and your hotel room key away from your phone, so they don't de-activate. Also use extra caution to keep them dry when on water rides.
- □ Follow the itinerary.
- ALWAYS conduct yourself with pride and maturity. You are representing your town, school, band and family. Make this a rewarding and enjoyable experience filled with memories. Chaperons will do frequent bag checks while in parks, looking for anything that may get you in trouble.
- Disney and Universal both prosecute shoplifters, and also remove people from the park for vaping or using CBD. If you buy something, be prepared to show a receipt to prove purchase at any time.
- □ Be flexible, things might change, or they might not go as you had planned. Make the best of the way things turn out.
- Do not be the last one to the meeting places before performances, or as we are leaving the park. Plan accordingly.
